January 12th, Lancing College: Vision and History

An illustrated talk by Jeremy Tomlinson. Lancing College Chapel, the Gothic cathedral-sized chapel on the hill overlooking Shoreham, is a Grade I listed building and the largest school chapel

in the world. Jeremy, a dedicated supporter and an expert on the chapel's amazing history, a part of Shoreham's past and present as well as its landscape, will tell who was responsible for getting the school and chapel built, where did the money come from and its fascinating history over the years.
